August — SIGNING OUR FAITH IN EUCHARISTIC HYMNS

Ephesians 5:19—20: “Sing psalms and hymns in your hearts,
giving thanks to God the Father at all times and
for everything in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ.”

The singing of hymns has been a part of our Christian celebration whenever we gather
for Holy Mass and at the many other devotions.

These hymns almost serve as a mini-catechism speaking truths about what occurs
when we gather for Holy Mass and when we receive Holy Communion.

Each of these Eucharistic hymns says something about our faith in Christ Jesus,
present to us during the celebration of the Holy Eucharist.
